## Day 4 - Siena and San Gimignano

In the morning, after breakfast and check-out, private transfer from Florence to the hotel in Siena. After the check-in, enjoy a 2-hour guided visit with a skilled private guide of this renowned medieval city. Siena is renowned for its well-preserved medieval architecture and rich cultural heritage. Famous for its distinctive fan-shaped Piazza del Campo, where the Palio horse race is held twice a year, Siena offers a glimpse into Italy's past with its narrow winding streets, stunning Gothic buildings, and vibrant art scene. You will enter Siena's Cathedral, or Duomo di Siena, which is a magnificent example of Italian Romanesque-Gothic architecture. Its construction began in the 12th century and was expanded over several centuries. The cathedral's striking black-and-white striped marble exterior and intricate façade, designed by Giovanni Pisano, make it one of Italy's most beautiful churches. At the end of the tour, meet your private driver for the transfer to a local winery in the Tuscan countryside. Here you will have the chance to enjoy a guided visit of the winery where you will walk through the cellar, where barrels of wine are stored, and learn about different wine varieties and the factors that influence their flavors. At the end of the visit, enjoy the tasting of their top labels accompanied by a typical Tuscan lunch.
