

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#### Day 1 - Pompeii

Upon arrival at Naples Airport, enjoy a private transfer to Sorrento with a 5-hour stop in Pompeii. #### Day 2 - Amalfi and Tramonti

Start the day with a private transfer to Amalfi, where you'll enjoy a 2-hour guided tour of this UNESCO World Heritage town. Known for its stunning cliffs, crystal-clear waters, and charming streets, Amalfi is a perfect blend of natural beauty and historic architecture.
